## Press communiqué dated 17th April 2015

1.The office of the Accountant General (A&E) has already taken up the work of revision of pension of those employees who retired from the service of the Government of Andhra Pradesh (AP) prior to 25.05.1998 in pursuance of GO No 223 Finance (HRM VI) Department dated 15.12.2014 issued by Government of AP. As on 17<sup>st</sup> April 2015, no order is received from the Government of Telangana for implementing the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No 367-5368 of 2005.

2.We have already issued authorization in respect of 11500 Pensioners of AP and 4000 more cases are under process.

3.Pensioners/ legal heirs are requested to note that revision is admissible only when the pensioner was alive on 25.05.1998 and the last pay drawn was more than the average emoluments.

4.Pensioners are requested to send their proposals through the respective Departments of the State Government. Advanced copies need not be sent. Detailed guidelines are available in our website (<a href="http://www.agap.cag.gov.in/ae-pension-cases.html">http://www.agap.cag.gov.in/ae-pension-cases.html</a>).

5.Due to heavy receipt of cases and in order to speed up the processing, we have dispensed with updation of status of revision cases in our website. Only the details of the authorized cases are uploaded in website. However it is assured that all cases will be processed within 30 working days from the date of receipt.

6.Pension sanctioning authorities are requested not to forward Service Registers. Also if the Pension was initially authorized by the State Audit Department revision proposal should be sent to them only. Treasury officers are requested not to insist for DDO's copy/ Pensioners copy for making payment.

7.Director of Treasuries and Accounts, AP has made arrangements to collect pension authorities from this office and to handover them to the respective Treasuries. We are sending Pensioner's copy to his/her address by ordinary post. Pensioners can also download their copies from our website(<a href="http://www.agap.cag.gov.in/ae-pension-cases.html">http://www.agap.cag.gov.in/ae-pension-cases.html</a> ) by providing their date of birth and the IVRS number communicated by this Office.
