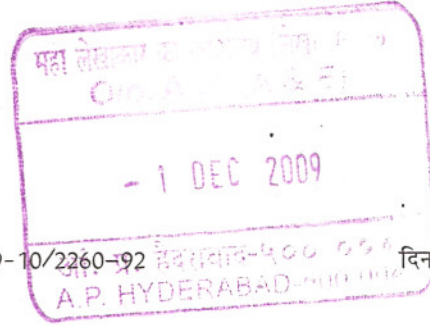

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Payment of second instalment of arrears of pension on account of implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Govt. of India's office Memoranda Nos. F.No.38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 1-09-2008 and 2-09-2008 vide which the orders for revision of pension on implementation of the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission in respect of Central Govt. employees including All India Services were issued. It was provided in these orders and also in this Department Office Memorandum No. Fin(Pen)B(10)-6/98-II dated 3-12-2008 that 40% of arrears of pension will be paid in the year 2008-09 and the remaining 60% in the year 2009-10. Accordingly, the first instalment of 40% arrears of pension has been paid in the year 2008-09.

2. The Govt. of India Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare vide O.M. No. F.No.38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 25-8-2009 has decided that the remaining 60% arrears of pension may now be paid to the pensioners. Accordingly, all Pension Disbursing Authorities including Public Sector Banks handling disbursement of pension are requested to disburse the remaining 60% of arrears of pension to the pensioners of All India Services Officers of Himachal Pradesh cadre latest by 30-9-09.


