The Government of Karnataka in their order No.FD(Spl) 07 CPP 2009 dated 10/12/2009 have sanctioned enhanced Dearness Allowance on pension @ **123% of basic pension with effect** from **1/7/2009** to the pensioners who were drawing , immediately before retirement pay in the UGC/AICTE/ICAR scales of pay and who retired on or after 1/7/2005. Payment of Dearness allowance to such retirees may be regulated accordingly.

Payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance on pension is subject to conditions detailed and stipulated in paras 4 and 5 of the said order.

ORDER NO. FD (SPL) 07 CPP 2009,
BANGALORE, DATED 10th DECEMBER 2009

Government are pleased to sanction increase in the rates of dearness allowance from 114% to 123% of the basic pension /family pension with effect from 1st July 2009 to pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the UGC/AICTE /ICAR scales of pay and who retired on or after from 1st July 2005:

2. The increase in Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.
3. As the pension is paid from the Public Sector Banks across across the State to the Pensioners, the pension paying branches of the Banks shall credit the DA for November 2009 to the accounts of the Pensioners.
4. Due to unprecedented floods in the northern part of Karnataka, Karnataka State Pensioners' Association has requested the Government to recover the entire DA Arrears payable to Pensioners for the period from July 2009 to Oct 2009 (4 months) and contribute the same to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund.
5. Accordingly, sanction is hereby accorded to recover four months arrears of DA and to remit the same to the Head of Account "8235-00-111-0-02-Public Contribution for Natural Calamity Relief". The Pensioners who are unwilling to contribute the arrears of DA of four months to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund may express their unwillingness in writing to the concerned Banks on or before 31.12.2009. In case no instruction in

writing is received from them within the specified time limit, the arrears of DA shall be deducted and credited to the above Head of account.

6. The procedure shall apply mutatis-mutandis in respect of Pensions payable by the Treasuries across Treasury Counters.

7. The payment on account of the increase in dearness allowance as per this order involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored..

8. The Treasuries Shall closely monitor the recovery and remittance to the Fund Account on receipt of Scrools/Schedules from the Banks.

9. The Accountant General (A&E) is also requested to conduct test check of recovery and remittance to the fund account.
