Sub: Grant of Dearness Allowance to pensioners of Karnataka State
with effect from 1.7.2009.

I am to invite a reference to Government of Karnataka, Finance Department Order NO.FD (SPL) 06 CPP 2009 Dated 25-11-2009 and to authorize you to pay the increase in DA from the existing **32.75 % to 38 %** of basic pension/family pension (Revised with effect from 1-7-2009) to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners including the pensioners/family pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pension/family pension is paid out of Consolidated Fund of the State **with effect from 1.7.2009.**

This order shall not be applicable to the pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement, (i) pay in the FNJPC (State Judicial Officers) and (ii) UGC, AICTE and ICAR Scales of pay and who retired on or after 1/7/2005. Separate Orders will be issued in respect of these pensioners. Payment of arrears of Dearness allowance to pensioners is subject to conditions stipulated in paras 4 & 5 of the said order.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Dearness Allowance to Pensioners/Family Pensioners-Revision of rates. —

Read: (1) Government Order No.FD(Spl) 11 CPP 2009 dated 14 November 2008..
(2) Order No.FD(Spl) 02 CPP 2009, Bangalore, Dated 19th May 2009.

ORDER NO. FD (SPL) 06 CPP 2009,
BANGALORE, DATED 25th NOVEMBER 2009

Government are pleased to sanction with effect from 1st July 2009 further increase in the rates of Dearness Allowance from the existing 32.75% to 38% of the basic pension/family pension to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/family pensioners of the aided educational institutions whose pension/family pension is paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State.


2. The increase in Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.
3. As the pension is paid from the Public Sector Banks across across the State to the Pensioners, the pension paying branches of the Banks shall credit the DA for November 2009 to the accounts of the Pensioners.
4. Due to unprecedented floods in the northern part of Karnataka, Karnataka State Pensioners' Association has requested the Government to recover the entire DA Arrears payable to Pensioners for the period from July 2009 to Oct 2009 (4 months) and contribute the same to the Calamity Relief Fund.
5. Accordingly, sanction is hereby accorded to recover four months arrears of DA and to remit the same to the Head of Account "8235-00-111-0-02-Public Contribution for Natural Calamity Relief". The Pensioners who are unwilling to contribute the arrears of DA of four months to the Calamity Relief Fund may express their unwillingness in writing to the concerned Banks on or before **15-12-2009**. In case no instruction in writing is received from them within the specified time limit, the arrears of DA shall be deducted and credited to the above Head of account.
6. The procedure shall apply mutatis-mutandis in respect of Pensions payable by the Treasuries across Treasury Counters.
7. This Order shall not be applicable to pensioners who were drawing immediately before retirement pay in the UGC, AICTE and ICAR scales of pay and who retired on or after 1st July 2005. Separate Orders will be issued in respect of these pensioners.

8. The payment on account of the increase in dearness allowance as per this order involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored..

9. The Treasuries Shall closely monitor the recovery and remittance to the Fund Account on receipt of Scrools/Schedules from the Banks.

11. The Accountant General (A&E) is also requested to conduct test check of recovery and remittance to the fund account.
