Pension – Implementation of the recommendations of Official Committee 2009 - Revision of pension and pensionery benefits – Payment of arrears accruing on account of pension revision for the period from 01-01-2007 to 31-05-2009 – Payment of second installment of arrears in 2010-11 – Drawal instruction – Issued.

In the Government Order first cited, among others, orders were issued in para 7 to the effect that the arrears due for the period from 01-01-2007 to 31-05-2009 after adjusting the Interim Arrears shall be paid in three equal annual instalments viz., first instalment in the year 2009-10, second instalment in the year 2010-11 and third and final instalment in the year 2011-12. Accordingly, first instalment of arrears has already been released in the year 2009-10 and the second instalment of arrears is due for payment in the year 2010-11.

- 2. In the Government order second cited, among others, orders were issued for revision of pension and pensionery benefits in respect of teachers and equivalent staff working in Universities, Government and Government aided Colleges as applicable to the State Government employees and to pay the arrears for such revision after adjusting the Interim Arrears in three equal annual instalments viz., first instalment in the year 2009-10, second instalment in the year 2010-11 and third and final instalment in the year 2011-12.
- 3. In the Government order third cited, orders were issued for revision of pension of persons who draw 1/3rd of Pension and who rendered Government service before absorption in Public Sector Undertakings.
- 4. I am directed to inform that the second installment of arrears claim for payment in the year 2010-11 as ordered in the Government orders cited may be drawn and paid to the pensioners after 01-04-2010.

Pension – Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme 1995 – Extension of Scheme to Family Pensioners – Time limit for option - Extension of time limit – Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

Government in their order first read above has extended the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme 1995 to all Family Pensioners including Teacher Family Pensioners with effect from 1st September 2009. In para 3 (iii) of the Government Order read above, it is stipulated that Family Pensioners who are willing to enroll under the Scheme shall exercise their option to the Pension Pay Officer/Treasury Officer/Sub-Treasury Officer/Manager of Public Sector Banks within 3 months from the date of issue of the orders (i.e) before 31.12.2009 to deduct a sum of Rs. 75/- from their family pension towards contribution to Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme. Further in para 3 (V) of the Government Order read above, it has been stated that if no such option is received from the existing Family Pensioners on or before the completion of three months from the date of issue of the orders, it shall be construed that they are not willing to enroll themselves under the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme.

- 2. Various Pensioners Associations have represented to the Government that the three months period upto 31.12.2009 was not adequate since wide publicity was not given among the Family Pensioners regarding the above orders and hence they could not exercise their option before 31.12.2009 and requested to extend the time limit for exercising their option for a further period of 3 months.
- 3. The Government, after careful consideration, has decided to accept the request of the Associations. Accordingly Government direct that the time limit for exercising option by the Family Pensioners to enroll themselves under the Tamil

Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme 1995 be extended upto 30.06.2010.

4. Pension Pay Officer / District Treasury Officers / Sub Treasury Officers and Branch Managers of all Public Sector Banks are requested to display this order in the Notice Board of their office and ensure that this order reaches all Family Pensioners drawing Family Pension through their office.

PENSION - Dearness Allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners - Revised rate admissible from 1st January, 2010 - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning the revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government pensioners / family pensioners as detailed below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)
With effect from 1st July 2009	27% of Pension / Family Pension

- 2. The Government of India, in its Office Memorandum fourth read above has enhanced the Dearness Allowance payable to its pensioners / family pensioners from 27% to 35% with effect from 1st January 2010.
- 3. Following the orders issued by the Government of India, the Government has now decided to sanction one additional instalment of dearness allowance at 8% to the pensioners / family pensioners of the State with effect from 1.1.2010. Accordingly, the Government sanction the revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government pensioners / family pensioners as indicated below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)	
1 st January 2010	35% of Pension / Family Pension	

- 4. The State Government employees who had drawn lump sum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertaking / Autonomous body/ Local body / Co-operative institution and have become entitled to restoration of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount and whose pay was revised as per the order issued in the Government Order 2nd read above, will also be entitled to the payment of Dearness Allowance at 35% on full Pension.
- 5. The Government also direct that the increase in Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners with effect from 1.1.2010.
- 6. While arriving at the revised Dearness Allowance, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including Public Sector Banks etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Allowance payable in each individual case.
- 7. Pending formal authorisation by the Accountant General, the Dearness Allowance shall be paid straightaway by the Pension Pay Officer, Chennai-6, Treasury Officers and Public Sector Banks concerned.
 - 8. This order will apply to the following categories of pensioners:-
 - i) Government pensioners, Teacher pensioners of aided and local body educational Institutions and other pensioners of local bodies.
 - ii) Present and future family pensioners; In the case of divisible family pensioners, Dearness Allowance shall be divided proportionately.
 - iii) Former Travancore-Cochin State pensioners drawing their pension on 1st November, 1956 in the Treasuries situated in the areas transferred to Tamil Nadu State on that date, i.e. Kanniyakumari District and Shencottah taluk of Tirunelveli District.
 - iv) Pensioners who are in receipt of special pensions under Extraordinary Pension Rules, Tamil Nadu and Compassionate Allowance.
- 9. The expenditure on Dearness Allowance payable to the pensioners shall be debited to:
 - " 2071. Pensions and Other Retirement Benefits 01. Civil 101. Superannuation and Retirement Allowances I. Non-Plan AC. Dearness Allowance to Pensioners 03. Dearness Allowance (D.P. Code 2071 01 101 AC 0306) "
