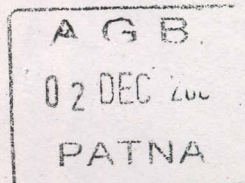

Subject :- The High Court and Supreme Court Judges (Salaries and Conditions of Service) Amendment Act, 2009 - Payment of second instalment of arrears of pay, pension, family pension etc.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Chapter IV Section 14 of the High Court and Supreme Court Judges (Salaries and Conditions of Service) Amendment Act, 2009 (No.23 of 2009) provides that difference of salary, pension or family pension payable to Judges of High Courts/Supreme Court or their families, as the case may be, but for this Act, shall be paid in two instalments, the first instalment of forty per cent. to be paid during the financial year 2008-2009 and the remaining sixty per cent. to be paid in the financial year 2009-2010. In terms of the above provision, the first instalment of 40% of arrears has already been paid. It has now been decided that the remaining 60% of arrears due to Judges on account of revision of salary, D.A. pension, family pension etc. may be released and paid after effecting the deductions on account of income tax and observing the prescribed checks. The Judges may also be permitted to deposit their arrears in their G.P.F. accounts.
