The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department notification of even number dated 2nd June, 2009 and to say that the Governor of Nagaland is pleased to sanction Dearness Relief to the Nagaland Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners to compensate them for rise in cost of living at the following revised rates, in supersession of the rates sanctioned earlier, w.e.f. 01.07.2009.

From the existing rate of 64% to 73% of Basic Pension (BP)/Family Pension(FP) (including Dearness Pension in case of pre-1.4.2004 pensioners/family pensioners) per month.

2. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
3. Other provision governing Dearness Relief to the pensioners such as regulation of Dearness Relief on re-employment, regulation of Dearness Relief where more than one pension is drawn, etc. will remain unchanged.
4. Authorised Public Sector Banks, Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to the pensioners on the basis of the above instruction.
