


**Sub: - Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners/  
Family Pensioners & Dearness Allowances to the Freedom  
Fighter Pensioners of Government of Goa - Revised rate  
effective from 01/01/2014.**

1. The Government of Goa, Finance (Rev. & Cont.) Department Secretariat, Porvorim, vide letter No. 12/3/82-Fin(R&C) Vol. I/886 dated 5<sup>th</sup> May 2014 have conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of Goa Government as contained in Office Memorandum No. 42/13/2012-P&PW(G) dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2014 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension, & Pensioners Welfare, New Delhi and Dearness Allowances made applicable vide letter No. 11/4/2012/HD(G)/1623 dated 29/04/2014 to the Freedom Fighter Pensioners of Government of Goa as contained in Office Memorandum No. 1/1/2014-E-II(B) dated 27/03/2014 by Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi and the said copies of the said Office Memorandum are enclosed for information and necessary action.
2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Government of India's Office Memorandum are applicable to Goa Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners, I am to authorize you to pay to the Goa Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners the installment of 10% of Dearness Relief raising it to 100% with effect from 01/01/2014 or date of commencement of pension whichever is later. Further, the said Office Memorandum No. 12/3/82-Fin(R&C) Vol. I/886 dated 5<sup>th</sup> May 2014 is also applicable to the following pensioners and should be paid relief accordingly.
  - (a). Ex-gratia pensioners (Montepio pensioners, pensioners drawing pensions on account of service rendered to Portuguese colonies and institute Ultramarine Pensioners) drawing pensions under C/B/D and E series.
  - (b). Pensao de Sanguie pensioners.
  - (c). Pensioners receiving pension under triple benefit scheme.
  - (d). Recipients of Ex-gratia i.e. Families of deceased pensioners/employees who were governed under EFU.
  - (e). Pensioners sanctioned pension under Education Act 15 of 1985 and drawing pension under series T.
  - (f). Freedom Fighters of Government of Goa



3. In case of Goa State Government Pensioners drawing pension in other States, the instructions contained in above Office Memorandum may be issued to all the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries/P.A.O where they are drawing their monthly pension.
4. This relief is not applicable to the following class of pensioners.
  - a. Pensioners drawing pension, which is granted after Independence for Political consideration(Ex-Rulers).
  - b. Retired High Court and Supreme Court Judges for whom order will be issued separately by administrative authorities concerned.
  - c. Pensioners of other states(PAO) Suspense) for whom separate orders are applicable.
  - d. M.L.A. Pensioners.
5. Instructions issued from time to time by this office as regards to payment of relief should be observed.
6. Wide Publicity may be given to this circular letter by displaying a copy on the office notice board or other permanent place in your office.
7. Pensioners who have drawn part payment of their pension through Treasury Office after 01-01-2014 and have subsequently opted for payment of their pension through Bank may also be paid arrears from the date of their retirement or from 01-01-2014 whichever is earlier without waiting for any individual orders from this office.



**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners –  
Revised rate effective from 1.1.2014.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/13/2012-P&PW(G) dated 3rd Oct, 2013 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief (DR) payable to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 90 % to 100% w.e.f. 1st Jan, 2014.

2. These orders apply to (i) All Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners and (v) The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan, who are Indian Nationals but receiving pension on behalf of Government of Pakistan and are in receipt of ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance of Rs.3500/- p.m. in terms of this Department's OM No. 23/1/97-P&PW(B) dated 23.2.1998 read with this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 15.9.2008.

3. Central Government Employees who had drawn lump sum amount on absorption in a PSU/Autonomous body and have become eligible to restoration of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount in terms of this Department's OM No. 4/59/97-P&PW (D) dated 14.07.1998 will also be entitled to the payment of DR @ 100% w.e.f. 1.1.2014 on full pension i.e. the revised pension which the absorbed employee would have



Dearness Pension subject to fulfillment of the conditions laid down in para 5 of the O.M. dated 14.07.98. In this connection, instructions contained in this Department's OM No.4/29/99-P&PW (D) dated. 12.7.2000 refer.

4. Payment of DR involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW(G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended vide this Department's OM No. F. No. 38/88/2008-P&PW(G) dated 9th July, 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension, will remain unchanged.

6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

8. The offices of Accountant General and Authorised Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA, II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

9. In their application to the pensioners/family pensioners belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.

10. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure conveyed vide their OM No.1(4)/EV/2004 dated 07th, April, 2014.

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject:- Payment of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees - Revised Rates effective from 1.1.2014.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.1-8/2013-E-II(B) dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 90% to 100% with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2014.

2. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M. No.1(3)/2008-E-II(B) dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

3. The additional installment of Dearness Allowance payable under these orders shall be paid in cash to all Central Government employees.

4. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary of March, 2014.

5. These orders shall also apply to the civilian employees paid from the Defence Services Estimates and the expenditure will be chargeable to the relevant head of the Defence Services Estimates. In regard to Armed Forces personnel and Railway employees, separate orders will be issued by the Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Railways, respectively.

6. In so far as the employees working in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued with the concurrence of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.



The same may be paid to the employees alongwith salaries for the month of April, 2014 with arrears from the month of January, 2014 to March, 2014.

As far as Corporations and Autonomous Bodies etc. are concerned, the contents of the said circular relating to the Dearness Allowances is now extended only to those Corporations/Autonomous Bodies etc. whose pay scales are exactly on par with or less than the Government of Goa Scales.
