Subject: Payment of Dearness Allowance to the Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts.

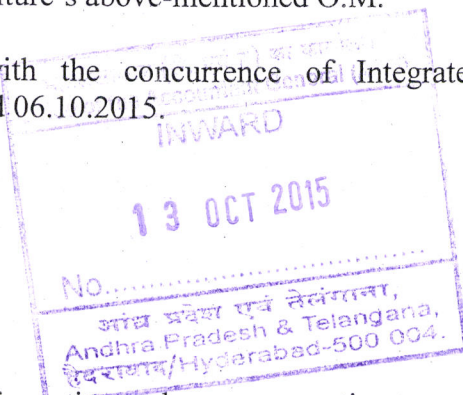
Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2015 on the above subject and to say that the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, vide O.M. No.1/3/2015-E.II(B) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2015 (copy enclosed) has revised the rates of Dearness Allowance (D.A.) payable to Central Government employees w.e.f.1<sup>st</sup> July, 2015. As per the revised rates the Central Government employees are entitled to Dearness Allowance @ 119% (revised from 113% to 119%).

2. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance are also admissible to the Members of All India Services by virtue of the provisions contained in Rule 3 of the All India Service (D.A) Rules, 1972.

3. By virtue of the provisions contained in Rule 2 of High Court Judges Rules, 1956 and Rule 6 of the Supreme Court Judges Rules, 1959, the Judges of the High Courts and Supreme Court are also entitled to the revised rates of Dearness Allowance w.e.f.01.07.2015 at the same rates (119%) as are admissible to the members of All India Service. The admissibility of Dearness Allowance would be subject to other conditions as stipulated by Department of Expenditure's above-mentioned O.M.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide Dy. No.2532/DS(Fin) dated 06.10.2015.


