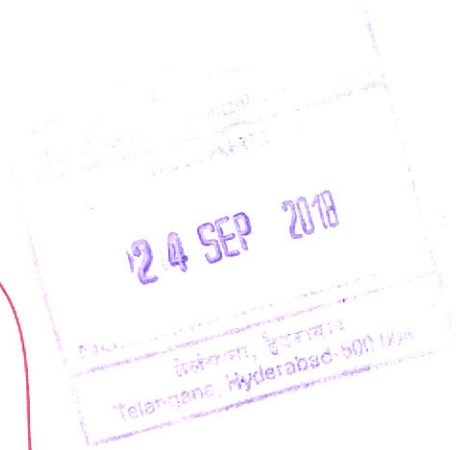

Sub:-Grant of Interim Relief to State Judicial officers pensioners/ family pensioners w.e.f 01.01.2016-regarding.
Ref:-GO(MS) No.118/2018/Home dated 18/07/2018.

As per Government Order cited. Government of Kerala ,Home Department in compliance with the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court have ordered that all judicial officers in Subordinate Courts may be granted 30% of the basic pay as on 01.01.2016 as interim relief with effect from 01.01.2016. It was also stated therein that (1) Dearness Allowance / Dearness Relief shall not be paid for interim relief (2) Arrears of interim relief will be paid.

The benefit of the Government Order is extended to all Pensioners/ family pensioners who have retired prior to / after 01.01.2016 and coming under the category of State judicial officers. They will be given interim relief @ 30% of basic pension (before commutation)/ family pension as on 01.01.2016. However, re-employed pensioners are not eligible for interim relief during their period of re- employment.

Hence you are kindly requested to make arrangements for payment of interim relief / arrears of interim relief @ 30% of basic pension with effect from 01.01.2016. The amounts so payable are liable to be adjusted in lump against the further determination of pension consequent to the implementation of final report of 2nd National Judicial Pay Commission.

ORDER

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 09.05.2017 in WP(C)No.643/2015 have appointed a committee to study the matter regarding the pay and allowances of judicial officers and the committee (Second National Judicial Pay Commission) submitted a report on the interim relief for the pay to the judicial officers. As per order read as 3rd paper above the Hon'ble Supreme Court directed all the respondents to implement the recommendations of the committee with effect from 01.05.2018.

2) In compliance with the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, Government are pleased to order as follows.

i) All Judicial Officers in subordinate Courts may be granted 30% of the basic pay as on 01.01.2016 as Interim Relief with effect from 01.01.2016.

ii) The interim Relief will stand as a separate component and the Interim relief is to be debited from the budget provision provided for pay.

iii) Dearness Allowance shall not be paid for Interim Relief.

iv) Arrears of Interim relief will be paid.

v) Judicial Officers Pensioners and Family Pensioners will also be given Interim relief corresponds to 30% of Basic Pension (Before Commutation) as on 01.01.2016. As regards the payment of arrears on Interim relief of Pension, the clause as above in case of Pay will also be made applicable.

vi) The amounts payable by way of interim relief now granted are liable to be adjusted in lump against the future determination of pay consequent to the implementation of final report of 2nd National Judicial Pay Commission.
