PENSION - Dearness Allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners - Revised rate admissible from 1st January, 2011 - Orders - Issued.

- 3. Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare, Office Memorandum F. No 42/15/2011 dated:29.03.2011

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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning the revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government pensioners / family pensioners as detailed below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)
With effect from 1st July 2010	45% of Pension / Family Pension

- 2. The Government of India, in its Office Memorandum third read above has enhanced the Dearness Allowance payable to its pensioners / family pensioners from 45% to 51% with effect from 1st January, 2011.
- 3. Following the orders issued by the Government of India, the Government has now decided to sanction one additional instalment of dearness allowance at 6% to the pensioners / family pensioners of the State with effect from 1.1.2011. Accordingly, the Government sanction the revised

rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government pensioners / family pensioners as indicated below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)
1 st January, 2011	51% of Pension / Family Pension

- 4. The Government also direct that the increase in Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners with effect from 1.1.2011.
- 5. While arriving at the revised Dearness Allowance, fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee if such fraction is 50 paise and above and shall be ignored if it is less than 50 paise. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including Public Sector Banks etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Allowance payable in each individual case.
- 6. Pending formal authorisation by the Accountant General, the Dearness Allowance shall be paid straightaway by the Pension Pay Officer, Chennai-6, Treasury Officers and Public Sector Banks concerned.
 - 7. This order will apply to the following categories of pensioners:-
 - Government pensioners, Teacher pensioners of aided and local body educational Institutions and other pensioners of local bodies.
 - ii) The State Government employees who had drawn lump sum payment on absorption in Public Sector Undertaking / Autonomous body / Local body / Co-operative institution and have become entitled to restoration of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount.
 - iii) Present and future family pensioners; In the case of divisible family pensioners, Dearness Allowance shall be divided proportionately.
 - iv) Former Travancore-Cochin State pensioners drawing their pension on 1st November, 1956 in the Treasuries situated in the areas transferred to Tamil Nadu State on that date, i.e. Kanniyakumari District and Shencottah taluk of Tirunelveli District.
 - Pensioners who are in receipt of special pensions under Extraordinary Pension Rules, Tamil Nadu and Compassionate Allowance.

- 8. The expenditure on Dearness Allowance payable to the pensioners shall be debited to:
 - " 2071. Pension and Other Retirement Benefits 01. Civil 101. Superannuation and Retirement Allowances I. Non-Plan AC. Dearness Allowance to Pensioners 03. Dearness Allowance (D.P. Code 2071 01 101 AC 0306)"

The expenditure on Dearness Allowance payable to the family pensioners shall be debited to

- " 2071. Pension and Other Retirement Benefits 01. Civil 105. Family Pensions I. Non-plan AC. Dearness Allowance to Family Pensioners of Tamil Nadu Government 03. Dearness Allowance (D.P. Code 2071 01 105 AC 0308) ".
- 9. Orders regarding sanction of dearness allowance to the widows & children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund / Non Pensionable Establishment beneficiaries of State Government and the former District Board who are drawing ex-gratia will be issued separately.
- 10. The Increased expenditure due to the sanction of Dearness Allowance in this order is allocable among the successor States as per the provisions laid down under the State Reorganization Act, 1956.

Sub: Revised Scales of Pay, 2009 - Implementation of the recommendations of Official Committee, 2009 on revision of scales of pay - Payment of arrears accruing on account of pay revision and pension revision for the period from 1-1-2007 to 31-5-2009 - Payment of third and final instalment of arrears in 2011-12 - Drawal instructions - Issued.

I am to invite your attention to the references cited.

- 2. In the Government Order 1st cited, among others, orders were issued in para 3(f) to the effect that the arrears due for the period from 1-1-2007 to 31-5-2009 after adjusting the Interim Arrears shall be paid in three equal annual instalments viz., 1st instalment in the year 2009-10, 2nd instalment in the year 2010-11 and 3rd and final instalment in the year 2011-12.
- 3. In the Government Order second cited, among others, orders were issued in para 7 to the effect that the arrears of pension due for the period from 1-1-2007 to 31-5-2009 after adjusting the Interim Arrears shall be paid in three equal annual instalments viz., first instalment in the year 2009-10, second instalment in the year 2010-11 and third and final instalment in the year 2011-12.
- 4. In the Government Order fourth cited, among others, orders were issued for revision of pension and pensionery benefits in respect of teachers and equivalent staff working in Universities, Government and Government aided Colleges as applicable to the State Government employees and to pay the arrears for such revision after adjusting the Interim Arrears in three equal annual instalments viz., first instalment in the year 2009-10, second instalment in the year 2011-11.
- 5. In the Government order fifth cited, orders were also issued for revision of pension of persons who draw 1/3rd of Pension and who rendered Government service before absorption in Public Sector Undertakings.
- 6. Based on the orders issued in the Government orders first, second, fourth and fifth cited, 1st and 2nd instalments of Pay / Pension arrears and difference in pensionery benefits have been released and paid in the years 2009-10, 2010-11 and the third and final instalment of Pay / Pension arrears is due for payment in the year 2011-12. However, doubts have now been raised as to whether the third and final instalment of arrears due to the employees / pensioners may be claimed and paid to them in April 2011. In this connection, I am directed to inform that the third and final instalment of the arrears due for payment in the year 2011-12 as ordered in the Government Orders cited may be drawn and paid to the employees / pensioners immediately.
