- Sub:- Extension of several benefits to pre-1.1.2006 pensioner/family pensioner of
- i) Principal and Lecturer holding pay structure of A.I.C.T.E as per G.O. no.574-TET(Poly) dated 13/9/2010 of **Govt.Sponsored Polytechnic**
  - ii) the employees under **Government Sponsored Polytechnic** (except Principal, Lecturer and other categories of staff covered by recommendation of the A.I.C.T.E.)

Sir,

In continuation of this office circular No.Pen.Co-ordn/248/259 Vol-II/227 dated 26/3/2014, it is informed that the Govt. of West Bengal, Department of Technical Education & Training, Polytechnic Branch in their Memo. No.323-TET(Poly) dated 27/3/2017 have adopted the following provisions for the categories of pensioners/family pensioners mentioned in the subject cited above and governed under Memo No. 996-TET(Poly)/4E-03-2011 & Memo No.1000-TET(Poly)/4E-03/2011 both dated 18/12/2012.

- i) In case of the pensioners who are in receipt of more than one family pension, the overall ceiling of Rs 3300/- will apply to the total of all pensions taken together.
- ii) The guidelines, mentioned in the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department, Pension Branch Memo No.s 635-F(Pen) dated 14/7/2010 and 1025-F(Pen) dated 24/12/2010 (circulated vide No. Pen. Co-ordn/300/92 dated 9/8/2010 and Pen. Co-ordn./300/213 dated 12/1/2011 respectively) are to be followed in allowing additional pension/family pension as mentioned in para 1(iv) of the earlier circular dated 26/03/2014. However, while making payment of additional pension/family pension, the stipulation as contained in Memo. No. 191(350)-F(Pen) dated 16/4/2012 (circulated vide No.Pen.Co-ordn/300/Vol-II/51/Vol-V/111/Vol-VI/50 dated 25/5/2012) as mentioned in para 1(iv) of this office earlier circular dated 26/3/2014 is to be kept in view.
- iii) As per para 4.4 of Memo No. 1000-TET(Poly)/4E-03/2011 dated 18/12/2012, the fixation of pension in respect of the Principals and Lecturers, guided under will be subject to the provision that the revised pension, in no case shall be lower than 50% of the minimum of the pay in the pay band plus the Academic Grade Pay in the revised pay structure corresponding to the pre-revised pay scale from which the pensioner had retired. The modus operandi of allowing such benefit will be as devised in Memo No.460-F(Pen) dated 20/5/2009 read with 1046-F(Pen) dated 19/11/2009 (circulated under No. Pen. Co-ordn/300/156 dated 28/1/2010). As such, in case of pensioners/family pensioners who
