Subject:- Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners / Family Pensioners and to the Retired Judicial Officers of the State of West Bengal – revised rate effective from 01/01/2015.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen.Co-ordn./55Vol.VI/142 Vol.III/152 dated 13/10/2014 it is stated that Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare under their O.M. No F 42/10/2014-P&PW(G) dated 27/04/2015 have sanctioned Dearness Relief at the rate of 113% with effect from 01/01/2015 in supersession of the rate mentioned in O.M. No F 42/10/2014-P&PW(G) dated 29/09/2014 to (i) All Civilian Central Government Pensioners/family pensioners (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners / family pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners and (v) The Burma Civilian Pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/ families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan, who are Indian national but receiving pension on behalf of Government of Pakistan and are in receipt of ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance of Rs.3500/- per month in terms of this Department's O.M No. 23/1/97-P&PW(B) dated 23/02/1998 read with the Department's O.M. No 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 15/09/2008.

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Besides, pursuant to the Government of West Bengal Judicial Department authority letter No 09 – J dated 02/01/2015, the above mentioned enhanced rate of dearness relief is also admissible with effect from 01/01/2015 to the retired officers of West Bengal Judicial Service and family pensioners of such category whose pension/family pension has been regulated /revised in terms of Judicial Department Memo No 7012 – J and 7014 – J both dated 25/10/2010.

This circular is issued to other Accountants General just to remind them the applicability of the order of the Govt. of India for allowing dearness relief to the Central Govt. pensioners/family pensioners, to the retired West Bengal Govt. Judicial Officers and family pensioners of such category as mentioned above, drawing pension/family pension from other states.

All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of Dearness Relief @ 113% to the above categories of pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01/01/2015, after proper adjustment.

Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

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It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including nationalized banks etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.

Charges for payment of above enhanced rate of dearness relief to the pensioners/family pensioners mentioned in para 1 above are debitable to the Government of India/Railway/Defence Accounts under the proper head of account as usual and the charges of its payment to the West Bengal Government Judicial officers are debitable to the Government of West Bengal under the head 2071 – Pension and other Retirement Benefits – 01 – Civil – 101 – Superannuation and Retirement allowances etc.
